

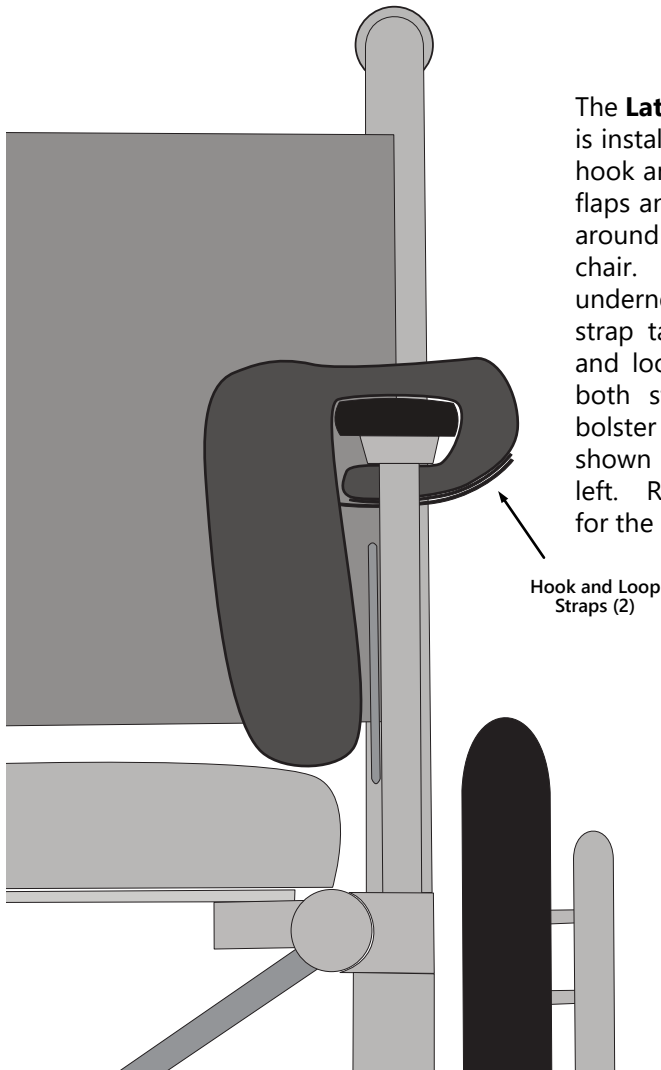
Lateral Support Bolster

Intended Use

The Lateral Support bolster is a low-profile, covered foam bolster designed to fit over most 10- or 16-inch wheelchair armrests. It may improve the user's overall comfort when seated in the wheelchair. The Lateral Support Bolster, when used in conjunction with an adjustable armrest, may help to reduce the risk of shoulder subluxation, pain and contractures at the elbow, wrist, and hand. The padding provides additional comfort at the elbow and wrist and may provide positioning support of the upper extremities. For power wheelchair users, this may also provide easier access to the joystick. The cover material protects the bolster foam from fluid absorption.

The lateral support bolster is intended for users who require mild support to appropriately position upper extremities, or for users who require protection due to uncontrolled arm movement. Lateral support bolsters should not be used as the only postural intervention for users who exhibit increased tone and/or heavy leaning and should be paired with mounted trunk lateral supports.

Installation and Use



The **Lateral Support Bolster** is installed by separating the hook and loop straps on the flaps and placing the bolster around the armrests of the chair. Fold the bottom flap underneath and pull the loop strap taut. Press the hook and loop sides together on both straps to secure the bolster to the armrest, as shown in the image to the left. Repeat the procedure for the right bolster.

NOTICE: The lateral support bolster should not be used as the only postural intervention for users who exhibit increased tone and/or heavy leaning and should be paired with mounted trunk lateral supports.

Care and Cleaning

We recommend that all products be examined on a regular basis for wear and function. Prior to use, check the foam for breakdown, the cover material and stitching on the webbing for stress or damage, and that hook-and-loop fasteners are securely fastened. If loose, frayed or broken cover material, webbing, or foam are discovered, discontinue use and contact your provider. Repairs should only be performed by a wheelchair service professional and with genuine Stealth Products parts, fasteners or items appropriate for the service required.

Surfaces may be cleaned of dust and dirt with a damp cloth. Ensure all cleaners are approved for finished steel, aluminum, plastic and upholstered surfaces. Cover may be removed for cleaning. Care should be taken not to damage foam during cover removal.
